# TENT & SLEEP SETUP

## Shelter & Sleeping (The Make-or-Break Gear)

- Tent (appropriate size + weather rating)
- Tent footprint or tarp
- Tent stakes
- Mallet or small hammer
- Sleeping bag (check temperature rating)
- Sleeping pad (critical for warmth + comfort)
- Pillow

### **Beginner Tip:**

Set up your tent at home once before your trip so you know how everything works.

# CLOTHING ESSENTIALS

## Clothing for Changing Weather

- ☐ Moisture-wicking base layers
- ☐ Insulating mid-layer (fleece or down)
- ☐ Waterproof jacket
- ☐ Extra socks (at least two pairs)
- ☐ Comfortable sleepwear
- ☐ Sturdy closed-toe shoes
- ☐ Camp sandals or slip-ons
- ☐ Hat
- ☐ Sunglasses

### **Important:**

Avoid cotton in cold or wet conditions – it holds moisture and dries slowly.

# CAMP KITCHEN BASICS

## Simple Camp Cooking Essentials

- ☐ Cooler or food storage container
- ☐ Camp stove + fuel
- ☐ Lighter or waterproof matches
- ☐ Basic cookware
- ☐ Eating utensils
- ☐ Refillable water bottles
- ☐ Coffee or tea setup
- ☐ Dish towel or sponge
- ☐ Trash bags

### **Pro Tip:**

Keep meals simple for your first trip. Pre-chop ingredients at home.

# SAFETY & PERSONAL ITEMS

## Safety & Personal Essentials

- Headlamp (hands-free lighting is best)
- First-aid kit
- Sunscreen
- Bug spray
- Toiletries
- Prescription medications
- Towel
- Multi-tool
- Portable phone charger
- Printed campsite information

# OPTIONAL COMFORT ITEMS

## Nice-to-Have Extras

- Camp chair
- Extra blanket
- Book or journal
- Deck of cards
- Hammock

These aren't essential – but they can make your trip more comfortable.
